## reserve wines

<b>Brokenwood ILR Semillon 2009</b>	109
Hunter Valley	
Winner of the 2015 James Halliday Best Semillon of the Year with 97 points	
This wine has a beautiful colour, and perfect grapes/ripening means nothing interferes with the gentle aging. As the wine warms up, the citrus and some florals come in. Bees wax and then 'toast' will come in a few years. Lively palate, plenty of citrus pith and seamless acidity. Sold out everywhere!	
<b>Yarra Yerring Light Dry Red Pinot Shiraz 2015</b>	112
Yarra Valley	
Winner of the 2017 James Halliday Winemaker of the Year with 98 points	
A piercing bouquet of incredible vitality, drive and intensity, the aromas and flavours anchored on red cherries with subtexts of strawberries and freshly picked raspberries.	
<b>Pooley Family Reserve Pinot Noir 2014</b>	144
Coal River Valley	
The nose starts to develop some secondary characters of damp earth and leather alongside dark cherry, rhubarb, and plum fruit. The palate reveals varietal dark cherry with a juicy and mineral core, a web of fine tannin weave in and out quality oak adding spice, and a current touch of smokiness.	
<b>Bleasdale Powder Monkey Shiraz 2013</b>	112
Longhorne Creek	
Pure crimson, an intense and powerful wine, the accent is on dense blackberry, liquorice and bitter chocolate, with savoury tannins running through the length of the palate.	

## reserve wines

- Seppelt Mount Ida Heathcote Shiraz 2003** 105  
Heathcote
- The nose shows intense dark berry, bramble, spice and prune characters supported by liquorice oak notes. The rich, full, warming palate shows spice and berry flavours, elegantly rounded tannins, and a long, lingering finish.
- Yalumba Single Site Shiraz 2006** 119  
Barossa Valley
- Poised and precise, with fine acidity, fine-grained tannin, and a savoury edge to the fruit that is completely alluring; elegance and power, seamlessly combined.
- Brokenwood Wade Block 2 Shiraz 2012** 84  
McLaren Vale
- Typical McLaren Vale flavours of black fruit, dark chocolate, Christmas Cake and Turkish Delight. Perfect McLaren Vale Shiraz colour with deep red hues and mouth coating tannins. The oak regime is all French, with approximately 30-40% being new which adds a vanillin note to the finish. A full-bodied wine with layers of flavour.
- Robert Mondavi Cabernet Sauvignon 2018** 138  
Nappa Valley
- With a bouquet of fruity aromas alike to sweetly ripened blackcurrants, juicy cherries and ripe plums. Palate with a powerful, concentrated body with fleshy texture, the wine has gently ripened tannins giving juicy fullness and very good structure. Ends on a note of herbal liquorice with long reverberation.
- Leeuwin Estate Art Series Cabernet Sauvignon 2006** 138  
Margaret River
- Medium bodied and elegant the palate displays flavours of ripe mulberry, cedar and spice followed by some light tobacco overtones. Well integrated fine grained, slightly dryish but balanced tannins with aftertaste of ripe mulberry, spicy cedar and light tobacco characters.
- Howard Park Abercrombie Cabernet Sauvignon 2007** 139  
Margaret River
- Red fruits, some hints of liquorice, beautiful cedary oak, cassis, blackcurrant and violets. Medium-bodied, firm but very fine. Beautiful shape and structure. Impeccable tannin. Length to burn. Just bottled but it shines. Top wine. Some tobaccoey-cabernet flavours on exit.
- Jim Barry XI Cabernet Sauvignon 2010** 97  
Clare Valley
- Early notes of aromatic rum 'n' raisin ending with a dark chocolate, cocoa bean palate. Chewy, succulent tannins - not as angular as expected. Generous mid-palate, fleshy, juicy. Balanced, with less noticeable oak.
